

OSLIS Elementary Overview – English Transcript

Welcome, students, to the Oregon School Library Information System, also known as OSLIS.

Elementary students begin here. There are three main areas to help you with your research projects. The Learn to Research section will take you through the four steps of the research process -- Plan, Find, Create, and Present.

Each of the four steps of the research process is introduced by a helpful video. Go to the Find, Plan, Create, and Present pages of OSLIS to view them.

The second section of OSLIS is Find Information. The Find Information section gives you many sources for your research. Click the icons to find sources that include articles, ebooks, and images for your project.

Oregon students, remember -- when using the sources on the Find Information page, you may need a username and password. Ask your teacher or librarian for the login information. Here are some of the videos, pictures, books, and magazines for your project and for fun.

The third section of OSLIS is a citation tool which will help you create a list of sources that you used in your project. This list is sometimes called a works cited page or a bibliography. To start using Citation Maker, follow the directions and enter the information from the sources into the boxes. If you need help when using Citation Maker, ask your parent, teacher, or librarian.
